Commitment and Action!

TB remains one of the leading causes of death from infectious disease worldwide. In Taiwan each year, approximately 15,000 persons become ill from TB; 1,300 die of this disease. The incidence rate of tuberculosis was 66.7 cases/100,000 population.

This year, the CDC Taiwan proposes the action plan for TB control:

- **TB patients each year down to 7500 in a decade;**
- **Decline of TB mortality**

We will work towards achieving the objectives through the shift of TB case detection rate, integration of TB laboratory network, advocacy and health promotion.
