

During Week 16 (April 15<sup>th</sup> to 21<sup>st</sup>) in 2018, no new severe case of enterovirus infection was confirmed (Figure 1). A total of four enterovirus infection cases with severe complications (EVSC) have been reported in 2018. These cases were caused by Coxsackie A4, Coxsackie B1, and Coxsackie B2. The majority of cases were below 1 year old (Table 1). Figure 2 shows the geographical distribution of these cases according to their residential areas.
