

Weekly Report of Enterovirus Infection




Figure 1 Trend of EVSC, Taiwan, 2017~2018




Figure 2 Geographical distribution of EVSC cases in 2018

During Week 17 (April 22<sup>nd</sup> to 28<sup>th</sup>) in 2018, one severe case of enterovirus 71 infection was newly confirmed (Figure 1). A total of five enterovirus infection cases with severe complications (EVSC) have been reported in 2018. These cases were caused by Coxsackie A4, Coxsackie B1, Coxsackie B2, and EV71.The majority of cases were below 1 year old (Table 1). Figure 2 shows the geographical distribution of these cases according to their residential areas.
