

Entry Quarantine Affidavit

Persons to whom the procedures apply:

R.O.C. nationals, foreign nationals holding an Alien Resident Certificate (ARC), and persons from Hong Kong, Macao and mainland China holding an ARC, if these groups of travelers are unable to present a COVID-19 RT-PCR test report,

Must provide verifying information, receive self-paid testing, and follow related quarantine measures after entry.

Emergency Situations

(the death or severe illness of a relative within the second degree of kinship; emergency medical care case)

Those who are traveling from places where self-paid COVID-19 tests are not available

Persons eligible for special agency programs that have received the CECC's approval

Other persons announced by the CECC

Travelers who return to Taiwan within three days of their departure, infants and children under the age of 7, those whose original flights to Taiwan were canceled, and persons who accompany travelers in emergency situations.

Those who do not meet the aforementioned requirements and cannot present a COVID-19 RT-PCR test report can sign an affidavit stating the reason and comply with relevant measures.

If the reason, after assessment, does not meet the requirements for related exceptions, the traveler shall be subject to penalty.
