Gonorrhea	<p>Reporting:</p> <p>A case met both clinical and one of the following laboratory criteria:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Clinical manifestation: a sexually transmitted disease caused by <i>Neisseria gonorrhoea</i> common manifested by urethritis, cervicitis, or salpingitis.2. Laboratory criteria:<ol style="list-style-type: none">(1) Isolation of <i>Neisseria gonorrhoea</i> in clinical laboratory testing.(2) Typical gram-negative diplococci on microscopic examination of a smear of clinical specimen.(3) Detection of <i>N. gonorrhoea</i> by molecular diagnostic method.3. Confirmed case: a clinical compatible case that is laboratory confirmed.	Report within one week
