## Travelers must present a COVID-19 RT-PCR test report issued within 3 days prior to boarding:

Those who test negative: shall follow the regular boarding and entry regulations.

Those who test positive: shall follow the quarantine regulations of local authorities; those in need of emergency medical assistance may apply to the CECC to return to Taiwan.

Those who do not have a report: must obtain the airline's consent to service in advance and sit in a designated area on the aircraft arranged by the airline; upon entry, the traveler must receive self-paid testing and follow related quarantine measures.

- Those who meet the conditions approved by the CECC and proactively present an affidavit and verifying information are exempted from penalty.
- Those who do not meet the conditions approved by the CECC and are traveling from places where self-paid COVID-19 tests are not available must sign the affidavit before boarding the aircraft. If the reason, after assessment, does not meet the requirements for related exceptions, the traveler shall be fined from NT\$10,000 to NT\$150,000 and may not receive disease prevention compensation. Those who are confirmed to have COVID-19 and are suspected of having infected other persons must bear relevant criminal liability.
