

Adjustments to mask-wearing regulations outdoors

A mask should be worn at all times when going out, except for the following situations in an outdoor environment:

NEW! Starting October 5:

- People in the agriculture, forestry, fishing, and animal husbandry sectors that work in open spaces (such as farm fields, fish ponds, forests and mountains) are not required to wear masks. However, they should carry a mask with them and maintain social distancing.
- People in forests and mountains (including forest recreation areas) or on the beach are not required to wear a mask. However, they should carry a mask with them and maintain social distancing.
- People in aforementioned situations should still wear a mask if there is a crowd, or when social distancing can't be maintained.
- Other applicable rules from the competent authority should be followed.

Continuation of the current regulations:

- Mask is not required when consuming food and beverages if social distancing can be maintained or dividers are available.
- Mask can be temporarily removed in venues where indoor dining is allowed, in the dining area of Taiwan Railway Administration and Taiwan High-Speed Rail, during diving or surfing or other venues and activities that comply with the CECC's or competent authority's rules.
