

Measures for Venues to Be **Eased This Week**

*Detailed epidemic prevention measures for each venue will be announced by the Ministry of Transportation and Communications, Ministry of Culture and Ministry of Education.

Category	Adjustments*
Taiwan Railway Administration (TRA) and Taiwan High-Speed Rail (THSR)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Food and beverages are allowed at the station paid area if social distancing can be maintained.
Tour buses	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Permitted to carry the same number of passengers as the approved number of seats without an additional upper limit.
Art performances, exhibitions and sports events	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Contact information registration, temperature checking, mask-wearing at all times. No eating or drinking.● Indoors: the number of people allowed in an indoor venue is based on the capacity of the venue and no longer subject to a limit of 80 people. The number of people can be seated is based on the actual number of seats with no checkerboard/staggered seating arrangement.● Outdoors: a 50% reduction in the maximum number of people (e.g. 50% of the actual number of seats), not subject to a limit of 300 people outdoors.● Onsite ticket sales are permitted with no reservation if social distancing can be maintained when people stand in line indoors and outdoors.● Social distancing must be maintained indoors and outdoors before and after the performance as well as during intermission.
