MPOX



Mpox is a viral zoonotic disease.

Sustainable person-to-person transmissions have been confirmed outside of endemic areas.

➤ Symptoms of monkeypox

- Rash or blisters (shown on face, limbs, genitals)
- Swollen lymph nodes
- Fever
- Exhaustion
- Muscle aches & headache

If you think you may have mpox symptoms, seek medical help urgently and inform healthcare providers of your travel and contact history.

➤ How it spreads?

- Intimate contact with an infected person or direct contact with patient's respiratory secretions, broken skin or mucous membranes
- Contact with infected animals
- Respiratory droplet transmission



➤ Epidemic situation

- Mpox cases have been identified in many countries, including Europe, America and other regions.
- Taiwan has confirmed the first imported case of mpox.
