In Taiwan, a total of 925 notifiable infectious disease cases were reported last week, and among those 522 were acute and 403 were chronic; 50 cases died. As for the clustering on disease outbreaks, 7 outbreak events were reported. ( 3 Varicella, 3 Diarrhea and 1 Unknown fever )

International epidemic: Dengue fever, Norovirus infection, Enterovirus, NDM-1, Typhoid fever, Measles, Acute Flaccid Paralysis and Cholera broke out last week in Malaysia, Singapore, Venezuela, Thailand, Lao PDR, Cambodia, China, Hong Kong, South Korea, Philippines, Zimbabwe, Congo, Mexico, Haiti and Dominican Republic. Taiwan CDC reminds all travelers to these areas to take adequate precaution and preventive measures.

In conclusion, according to Taiwan CDC surveillance data, indigenous Dengue Fever epidemic in southern Taiwan continued to slow down. RODs consultation rates for diarrhea still rise and gradually approach the epidemic threshold; RODs consultation rates for influenza also show a rising. Since the current outbreak of dengue fever in southern Taiwan has become stable. The epidemic alert of this week lowered to yellow light signal.
