In Taiwan, a total of 846 notifiable infectious disease cases were reported last week, and among those 456 were acute and 390 were chronic; 12 cases died. As for the clustering on disease outbreaks, 15 outbreak events were reported. ( 1 Dengue fever, 1 Typhoid fever, 1 Varicella, 2 Shigellosis, 6 Diarrhea and 4 Influenza-like infection )

International epidemic: Dengue fever, Gastroenteritis, Pertussis, Malaria, Rift valley fever, Trichinosis, Cholera, Measles, Mumps and Plague broke out last week in Malaysia, Singapore, Sri Lanka, Honduras, Japan, Australia, South Africa, Mauritania, Argentina, Papua New Guinea, USA, Haiti, Dominican Republic, Germany, France, Spain and Tanzania. Taiwan CDC reminds all travelers to these areas to take adequate precaution and preventive measures.

In conclusion, according to Taiwan CDC surveillance data, indigenous Dengue Fever epidemic in southern Taiwan continued to slow down, cases occurred mainly in the Kaohsiung City; RODs consultation rates for diarrhea still rise and will approach the epidemic threshold; RODs consultation rates for influenza also show a rising, the epidemic has been gradually reaching the peak. The epidemic alert of this week is keep to yellow light signal.
