In Taiwan, a total of 936 notifiable infectious disease cases were reported last week, and among those 541 were acute and 395 were chronic; 8 cases died. As for the clustering on disease outbreaks, 7 outbreak events were reported. ( 1 Amoebiasis, 5 Diarrhea and 1 Influenza-like-illness )

International epidemic: Dengue fever, Enterovirus, Rabies, Varicella, Cholera, Acute Flaccid Paralysis, Leptospirosis, Measles and Cryptosporidiosis broke out last week in Philippines, Thailand, Vietnam, Singapore, Malaysia, Sri Lanka, China, Hong Kong, Russia, Congo, Chad, Dominican Republic, Haiti, Nicaragua, Spain and Sweden. Taiwan CDC reminds all travelers to these areas to take adequate precaution and preventive measures.

In conclusion, according to Taiwan CDC surveillance data, indigenous Dengue Fever epidemic in southern Taiwan continued to decrease. RODs consultation rates for diarrhea still continue to rise; RODs consultation rates for influenza also show a rising. Since dengue fever epidemic is still serious. The epidemic alert of this week is keep to orange light signal.
