In Taiwan, a total of 779 notifiable infectious disease cases were reported last week, and among those 327 were acute and 452 were chronic; 24 cases died. As for the clustering on disease outbreaks, 7 outbreak events were reported. (6 Diarrheas and 1 upper respiratory tract infection)

International epidemic: Q fever, measles, Rift Valley fever, hand-foot-mouth disease, hepatitis A, typhoid fever, Chikungunya fever broke out last week in the Netherlands, Philippines, Bulgaria, Nigeria, South Africa, Thailand, Australia, France, Fiji, Malaysia and Indonesia. Dengue Fever broke out in Thailand, Malaysia and Southeast Asia countries. Taiwan CDC reminds all travelers to these areas to take adequate precaution and preventive measures.

In conclusion, according to Taiwan CDC surveillance data, no newly confirmed Enterovirus severe complicate cases and Chikungunya fever cases broke out last week, as well as Diarrheas ER visits and cluster events were lower than previous weeks. The domestic epidemic alert index of this week is, therefore, shifted to green warning light signal.
