In Taiwan, a total of 800 notifiable infectious disease cases were reported last week, and among those 332 were acute and 468 were chronic; 12 cases died. As for the clustering on disease outbreaks, 12 outbreak events were reported. (1 Dengue fever, 2 Varicella, 1 Food poisoning, 7 Diarrheas and 1 Influenza-like infection)

International epidemic: Listeriosis, Q fever, Measles, Cholera, Rabies, and Meningitis broke out last week in Canada, Netherlands, Bulgaria, Papua New Guinea, Indonesia and Burkina Faso. Dengue Fever broke out in Brazil, Colombia, Paraguay, Sri Lanka and Southeast Asia countries. Taiwan CDC reminds all travelers to these areas to take adequate precaution and preventive measures.

In conclusion, according to Taiwan CDC surveillance data, although some cluster events were reported last week, however, no newly confirmed Enterovirus severe complicate cases and Chikungunya fever cases broke out last week. The domestic epidemic alert index of this week is, therefore, kept at green warning light signal.
