In Taiwan, a total of 830 notifiable infectious disease cases were reported last week, and among those 408 were acute and 422 were chronic; 10 cases died. As for the clustering on disease outbreaks, 5 outbreak events were reported. (1 Pertussis, and 4 Diarrheas)

Last week, in addition to one newly confirmed enterovirus infection with severe complication case was reported, RODS consultation rate has risen into the alert zone. First indigenous Dengue Fever case was reported last week. As to the mosquito disease vector indices, none of City/County in south of Taiwan exceeds the critical threshold.

International epidemic: Hand-foot-mouth disease, Chikungunya fever, Measles, Meningitis, Norovirus infection and Dengue Fever broke out last week in China, Hong Kong, Singapore, Madagascar, South Africa, Burkina Faso, United Kingdom, Norway, France, Sweden, Denmark, Indonesia, Malaysia, India and Paraguay. Taiwan CDC reminds all travelers to these areas to take adequate precaution and preventive measures.

In conclusion, according to Taiwan CDC surveillance data, one newly confirmed enterovirus infection with severe complication case was reported and consultation rate has risen into the alert zone; first indigenous Dengue Fever case was reported last week. The domestic epidemic alert index of this week is, therefore, lifted to yellow warning light signal.
