In Taiwan, a total of 832 notifiable infectious disease cases were reported last week, and among those 431 were acute and 401 were chronic; 12 cases died. As for the clustering on disease outbreaks, 9 outbreak events were reported. (5 Diarrheas, 1 Chikungunya, 1 Dengue Fever, 1 Varicella and 1 upper respiratory tract infection)

Last week, no indigenous dengue fever case was newly confirmed, a total of 885 indigenous dengue cases were confirmed since epidemic season of last year. As to the mosquito disease vector indices, none of City/County exceeds the critical threshold.

International epidemic: Mumps, Malaria, Measles, Yellow Fever, Chikungunya and Hand, Foot and Mouth Disease broke out last week in the United States, Ireland, South Africa, Zimbabwe, Central African Republic, Madagascar, Malaysia, Indonesia and Thailand. Dengue Fever broke out in Brazil, Sri Lanka, Thailand, Malaysia and Southeast Asia countries. Taiwan CDC reminds all travelers to these areas to take adequate precaution and preventive measures.

In conclusion, according to Taiwan CDC surveillance data, imported Chikungunya cases broke out last week, as well as Diarrheas ER visit and cluster events were relatively high. The domestic epidemic alert index of this week is, therefore, maintained yellow warning light signal.
