In Taiwan, a total of 733 notifiable infectious disease cases were reported last week, and among those 387 were acute and 346 were chronic; 12 cases died. As for the clustering on disease outbreaks, 4 outbreak events were reported. (Measles, Dengue Fever, Pertussis and Chickenpox.),

International epidemic: Enterovirus, Dengue Fever, Measles, Rabies, Leptospirosis, Norovirus, Mumps, and Q fever broke out last week in China, Vietnam, Brazil, Paraguay, New Zealand, Singapore, Germany, South Africa, Angola, Argentina, United States and the Netherlands. Taiwan CDC reminds all travelers to these areas to take adequate precaution and preventive measures.

In conclusion, according to Taiwan CDC surveillance data, one indigenous Dengue Fever, Enteroviruses infection with severe complications, and Enterovirus physician consultation rate were relatively higher than last week, and the rate still kept in the alert zone; first Hantavirus syndrome and Rubella confirmed cases appeared in this year; Measles, Dengue Fever, and Pertussis outbreak events. The domestic epidemic alert index of this week is, therefore, kept to yellow warning light signal.
