In Taiwan, a total of 918 notifiable infectious disease cases were reported last week, and among those 478 were acute and 440 were chronic; 17 cases died. As for the clustering on disease outbreaks, 10 outbreak events were reported. (1 Botulism poisoning, 1 Amoebiasis, 1 Varicella, 5 Diarrheas and 2 Influenza-like-illness)

International epidemic: Enterovirus, Rabies, Measles, Cholera, Dengue Fever, Norovirus broke out last week in China, Hong Kong, Indonesia, Philippines, Zambia, Vietnam, Kenya, Malaysia, Paraguay, El Salvador, Dominican Republic, Puerto Rico, and United Kingdom. Taiwan CDC reminds all travelers to these areas to take adequate precaution and preventive measures.

In conclusion, according to Taiwan CDC surveillance data, one Enteroviruses infection with severe complications was confirmed, and Enterovirus physician consultation rate were relatively higher than last week, and the rate still kept in the alert zone; first indigenous Rubella confirmed case appeared in this year; in addition, Botulism poisoning and Amoebiasis outbreaks appeared last week. The domestic epidemic alert index of this week is, therefore, kept to yellow warning light signal.
