In Taiwan, a total of 819 notifiable infectious disease cases were reported last week, and among those 407 were acute and 412 were chronic; 27 cases died. As for the clustering on disease outbreaks, 12 outbreak events were reported. (4 Varicella, 2 Pertussis, 1 Dengue Fever, 2 Influenza-like-illness and 3 Diarrheas)

International epidemic: Enterovirus, Rabies, Cholera, Malaria, Measles, Dengue Fever, Hantavirus, Q fever and Acute Flaccid Paralysis broke out last week in China, Hong Kong, Singapore, Thailand, India, Venezuela, Zimbabwe, Bulgaria, Canada, Sudan, Colombia, Chile, Netherlands and Tajikistan. Taiwan CDC reminds all travelers to these areas to take adequate precaution and preventive measures

In conclusion, according to Taiwan CDC surveillance data, three cases of Enteroviruses infection with severe complications were confirmed, and Enterovirus physician consultation rate were relatively higher than last week, and the rate still kept in the alert zone; 3 indigenous Dengue Fever cases were confirmed, and vector index was higher than threshold in Kaohsiung City. In addition, Pertussis, Dengue Fever, and Varicella outbreak events appeared last week. The domestic epidemic alert index of this week is, therefore, kept to yellow warning light signal.
