In Taiwan, a total of 850 notifiable infectious disease cases were reported last week, and among those 428 were acute and 422 were chronic; 8 cases died. As for the clustering on disease outbreaks, 10 outbreak events were reported. (1 Pertussis, 1 Botulism poisoning, 1 Chick pox and 7 Diarrheas)

International epidemic: Q fever, Measles, Cholera, Enterovirus infections, Chikungunya fever, Dengue fever, Rift Valley fever, Malaria, and Meningitis broke out last week in Netherlands, Bulgaria, Cambodia, Vietnam, Malaysia, Thailand, Sri Lanka, South Africa, Angola, Chad and Ecuador. Taiwan CDC reminds all travelers to these areas to take adequate precaution and preventive measures.

In conclusion, according to Taiwan CDC surveillance data, although no newly confirmed enterovirus infection with severe complication case was reported and consultation rate slightly decreased, therefore the rate still kept in the alert zone; and pertussis and botulism poisoning clusters were reported last week. The domestic epidemic alert index of this week is, therefore, kept to yellow warning light signal.
