In Taiwan, a total of 970 notifiable infectious disease cases were reported last week, and among those 500 were acute and 470 were chronic; 14 cases died. As for the clustering on disease outbreaks, 15 outbreak events were reported. (1 Pertussis, 1 Influenza severe case, 1 Varicella, 5 Influenza-like-illness, 3 Diarrhea, 2 Upper respiratory tract infection and 2 unknown fever)

International epidemic: Enterovirus, Dengue Fever, Rabies, Cholera, Rift Valley Fever, AFP and Anthrax broke out last week in China, Hong Kong, Singapore, Thailand, Malaysia, Indonesia, South Africa, Iraq and United Kingdom. Taiwan CDC reminds all travelers to these areas to take adequate precaution and preventive measures.

In conclusion, according to Taiwan CDC surveillance data, one Influenza severe case was confirmed, and some Influenza-like-illness outbreak events were reported last week. Enterovirus physician consultation rates were relatively higher than last week, but no cases of Enteroviruses infection with severe complications and indigenous Dengue Fever were newly confirmed last week. The domestic epidemic alert index of this week is, therefore, kept to yellow warning light signal.
