In Taiwan, a total of 932 notifiable infectious disease cases were reported last week, and among those 478 were acute and 454 were chronic; 20 cases died. As for the clustering on disease outbreaks, 10 outbreak events were reported. (1 Pertussis, 1 Varicella, 1 Leptospirosis, 1 Diarrhea, 4 Influenza-like-illness and 2 Upper respiratory tract infection)

International epidemic: Enterovirus, Dengue Fever, Malaria, Cholera, Pertussis, Measles, Hantavirus, AFP, Mumps and Hepatitis A broke out last week in China, Macau, Malaysia, El Salvador, Honduras, Philippines, India, Vietnam, Democratic Republic of the Congo, Bulgaria, Germany, Tajikistan, Netherlands and Russia. Taiwan CDC reminds all travelers to these areas to take adequate precaution and preventive measures.

In conclusion, according to Taiwan CDC surveillance data, no cases of indigenous Dengue Fever and Enteroviruses infection with severe complications were newly confirmed last week. However, Enterovirus physician consultation rate rose to the epidemic zone. The domestic epidemic alert index of this week is, therefore, kept to yellow warning light signal.
