In Taiwan, a total of 865 notifiable infectious disease cases were reported last week, and among those 424 were acute and 441 were chronic; 115 cases died. As for the clustering on disease outbreaks, 13 outbreak events were reported. (1 Rubella, 1 Pertussis, 1 Q fever, 1 Varicella, 1 Scrub typhus, 1 Amoebiasis, 1 Influenza severe case and 1 Diarrhea, 3 Upper respiratory infection and 2 Influenza-like-illness)

International epidemic: Enterovirus, Dengue fever, Measles, Typhoid fever, Malaria, AFP, Cholera and Chikungunya fever broke out last week in China, Hong Kong, Macao, Singapore, Vietnam, Thailand, Russia, New Zealand, Fiji, Tajikistan, Kenya and Gabon. Taiwan CDC reminds all travelers to these areas to take adequate precaution and preventive measures.

In conclusion, according to Taiwan CDC surveillance data, first death of Japanese Encephalitis and one case of Enteroviruses infection with severe complications were confirmed last week; several Larvae Index data in Kaohsiung City were over threshold, but no confirmed indigenous Dengue fever broke out last week. The domestic epidemic alert index of this week is, therefore, kept to yellow warning light signal.
