In Taiwan, a total of 857 notifiable infectious disease cases were reported last week, and among those 413 were acute and 444 were chronic; 13 cases died. As for the clustering on disease outbreaks, 10 outbreak events were reported. (1 Severe complicated influenza, 1 Shigellosis, 1 Enterovirus, 2 Varicella, 2 Upper respiratory infections and 3 Influenza-like-illness)

International epidemic: Enterovirus, Dengue Fever, Cholera, West Nile Fever, Measles, Pertussis and NDM-1 broke out last week in China, Hong Kong, Singapore, Thailand, Vietnam, Malaysia, Costa Rica, Honduras, Nepal, India, Pakistan, Cameroon, Greece, Zimbabwe, USA and UK. Taiwan CDC reminds all travelers to these areas to take adequate precaution and preventive measures.

In conclusion, according to Taiwan CDC surveillance data, new H1N1 and Melioidosis death cases, indigenous Dengue fever case and severe complicated influenza clusters were confirmed last week; however, no Enterovirus infection with severe complications case and Japanese Encephalitis case were confirmed last week. The domestic epidemic alert index of this week is, therefore, kept to yellow warning light signal.
