In Taiwan, a total of 927 notifiable infectious disease cases were reported last week, and among those 545 were acute and 382 were chronic; 11 cases died. As for the clustering on disease outbreaks, 18 outbreak events were reported. ( 1 Varicella, 16 Diarrhea and 1 Upper respiratory infection )

International epidemic: Dengue Fever, Typhoid Fever, Measles, Cholera, Salmonellosis, Yellow Fever and Varicella broke out last week in Malaysia, Singapore, Sri Lanka, Philippines, Tanzania, Zimbabwe, Dominican Republic, Haiti, USA, Canada, Côte d'Ivoire, Uganda and Hong Kong. Taiwan CDC reminds all travelers to these areas to take adequate precaution and preventive measures.

In conclusion, according to Taiwan CDC surveillance data, indigenous Dengue Fever epidemic in southern Taiwan decreased obviously; Consultation rates for diarrhea in ER and outpatient continued to rise, clusters were continually reported in several regions; RODs consultation rates for influenza also increased rapidly, adenovirus and influenza virus were widespread in community. The epidemic alert of this week is keep to yellow light signal.
