In Taiwan, a total of 883 notifiable infectious disease cases were reported last week, and among those 461 were acute and 422 were chronic; 34 cases died. As for the clustering on disease outbreaks, 9 outbreak events were reported. (1 Varicella, 1 Shigellosis, 1 Upper respiratory infection, 1 Influenza-like infection and 5 Diarrhea)

International epidemic: Measles, Dengue Fever, Rabies, Ross River Virus Infection, Meningococcal meningitis, E. coli O157 and Invasive Pneumococcal Disease broke out last week in USA, Philippines, Indonesia, Australia, Paraguay, Chad, Scotland and Japan. Taiwan CDC reminds all travelers to these areas to take adequate precaution and preventive measures.

In conclusion, according to Taiwan CDC surveillance data, influenza epidemic showed a steady downward trend, but still in the epidemic period; the indigenous rubella and measles confirmed cases were confirmed last week; diarrhea epidemic has been gradually slowing down, but should take precautions to prevent the epidemic clusters. The epidemic alert of this week is keep to yellow light signal.
