In Taiwan, a total of 877 notifiable infectious disease cases were reported last week, and among those 476 were acute and 401 were chronic; 12 cases died. As for the clustering on disease outbreaks, 15 outbreak events were reported. (1 Measles, 1 Pertussis, 1 Varicella, 1 Fever of unknown origins, 5 Upper respiratory infections, 4 Diarrhea and 2 Influenza-like infections)

International epidemic: Polio, Legionellosis, Plaque, Dengue Fever and Measles broke out last week in DR Congo, Chad, Pakistan, USA, Madagascar, Australia, India, Brazil, Paraguay, Lao, Malaysia, Thailand, Philippines, Ukraine and Chile. Taiwan CDC reminds all travelers to these areas to take adequate precaution and preventive measures.

In conclusion, according to Taiwan CDC surveillance data, influenza epidemic showed a steady decline; there were several shigellosis clusters occurred in particular counties and institutions last week; enterovirus epidemic season is about to begin, continue closely monitoring the epidemic changes. The epidemic alert of this week is keep to yellow light signal.
