In Taiwan, a total of 915 notifiable infectious disease cases were reported last week, and among those 553 were acute and 362 were chronic; 52 cases died. As for the clustering on disease outbreaks, 7 outbreak events were reported. (1 Varicella, 1 Diarrhea, 2 Upper respiratory infections and 3 Influenza-like infections)

International epidemic: Measles, Cholera, Rabies and Acute Flaccid Paralysis broke out last week in Turkey, Norway, Philippines, Australia, Haiti, Dominican Republic, Indonesia and Russia. Taiwan CDC reminds all travelers to these areas to take adequate precaution and preventive measures.

In conclusion, according to Taiwan CDC surveillance data, influenza epidemic has reached its peak on 4th week; consultation rates for influenza in ER and outpatient gradually decreased. Consultation attendances for diarrhea in ER and outpatient decreased gradually. The epidemic alert of this week is keep to yellow light signal.
