In Taiwan, a total of 939 notifiable infectious disease cases were reported last week, and among those 493 were acute and 446 were chronic; 13 cases died. As for the clustering on disease outbreaks, 10 outbreak events were reported. (2 Measles, 2 Varicella, 2 Diarrhea, 1 Rubella, 1 Pertussis, 1 Amoebiasis and 1 Influenza-like infections)

International epidemic: Measles, Dengue Fever, E. coli O157, Salmonellosis, Carbapenem-resistant *Klebsiella pneumoniae* (CRKP) and *Serratia marcescens* broke out last week in UK, France, USA, Paraguay, Bolivia, Sri Lanka, Mexico and Brazil. Taiwan CDC reminds all travelers to these areas to take adequate precaution and preventive measures.

In conclusion, according to Taiwan CDC surveillance data, influenza epidemic showed a steady decline; measles confirmed cases increased last week; Rubella imported cases from Vietnam increased than in previous years; enterovirus epidemic season is about to begin, continue closely monitoring the epidemic changes. The epidemic alert of this week is keep to yellow light signal.
