In Taiwan, a total of 931 notifiable infectious disease cases were reported last week, and among those 468 were acute and 463 were chronic; 6 cases died. As for the clustering on disease outbreaks, 5 outbreak events were reported. (2 Varicella and 3 Diarrhea)

International epidemic: Measles, Dengue Fever, Malaria, Cholera, Rabies, Pertussis, Rubella, Hand-Foot-Mouth Disease and Meningococcal Meningitis broke out last week in Thailand, USA, Belgium, Spain, Vietnam, Malaysia, Sri Lanka, India, Argentina, Paraguay, UK, Zimbabwe, Indonesia, Chile and China. Taiwan CDC reminds all travelers to these areas to take adequate precaution and preventive measures.

In conclusion, according to Taiwan CDC surveillance data, enterovirus consultation rate continuously increased for 4 weeks and gradually into the epidemic season, should closely monitor the epidemic changes. WHO indicated that the current influenza activity in the northern hemisphere regions is back to baseline levels, showing the season is now ending, and the domestic influenza virus activity was mainly by adenovirus for 4 weeks, it concluded the influenza epidemic is ending. The epidemic alert of this week is down to green light signal.
