Entry quarantine procedures for travelers who cannot present COVID-19 RT-PCR test reports prior to boarding

Persons to whom the procedures apply and the conditions:

- Emergency situations: the death or severe illness of a relative within the second degree of kinship; emergency medical care case.
- Place of departure has been announced as a "country/region where COVID-19 RT-PCR test reports cannot be obtained" by the CECC.
- Persons eligible for special agency programs that have received the CECC's consent
- Other persons announced by the CECC
- Travelers who do not meet the aforementioned conditions can enter Taiwan after declaring a specific reason and shall be fined if any fact of violation is found.

Persons:

- R.O.C. nationals
- Persons from Hong Kong, Macao, and mainland China who hold an Alien Resident Certificate (ARC)
- Foreign nationals holding an ARC
