

## Summary





Figure 1. Trend of Enterovirus Isolates, 2021-2022

According to the laboratory surveillance<sup>1</sup>, the number of enterovirus isolates continued to be low in the past 4 weeks (Figure 1). During week 19, the total number of outpatient and ER visits for enterovirus infection was 503, which was far below the national baseline (11,000 visits), show as Figure 2.




Figure 3. Trend of EVSC, 2021-2022

As of May 16, 2022, no new EVSC<sup>2</sup> case was confirmed in 2022(Figure 3).
