Week 40, October 3 - 9, 2021

Summary




Figure 1. Trend of Enterovirus Isolates, 2020-2021




Figure 2. Trend of outpatient and ER visits for enterovirus infection, 2020-2021

According to the laboratory surveillance¹, the number of enterovirus isolates continued to be low in the past 4 weeks (Figure 1). During week 40, the total number of outpatient and ER visits for enterovirus infection was 733, which was far below the national baseline (11,000 visits), show as Figure 2.




Figure 3. Trend of EVSC, 2020-2021

As of October 11, 2021, no new EVSC² case was confirmed in 2021(Figure 3).
