

Summary

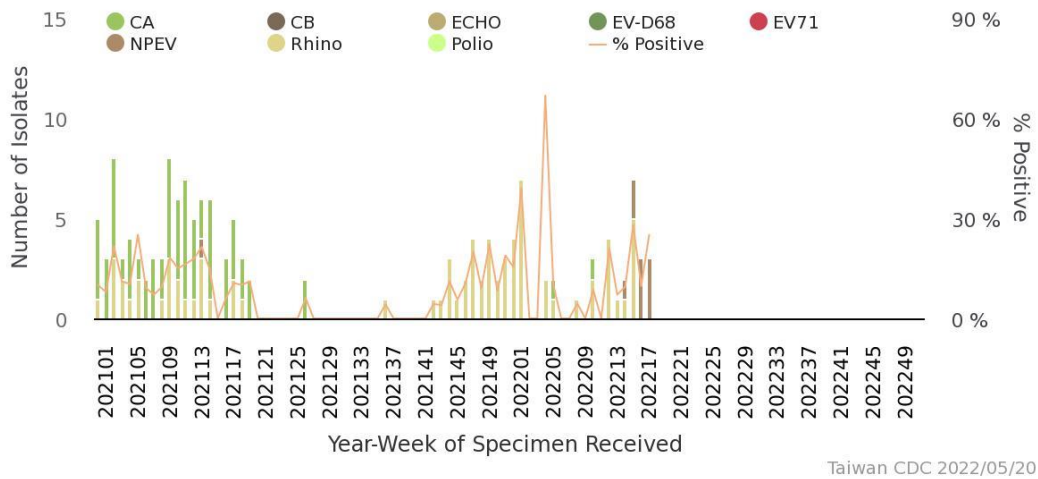


Figure 1. Trend of Enterovirus Isolates, 2021-2022

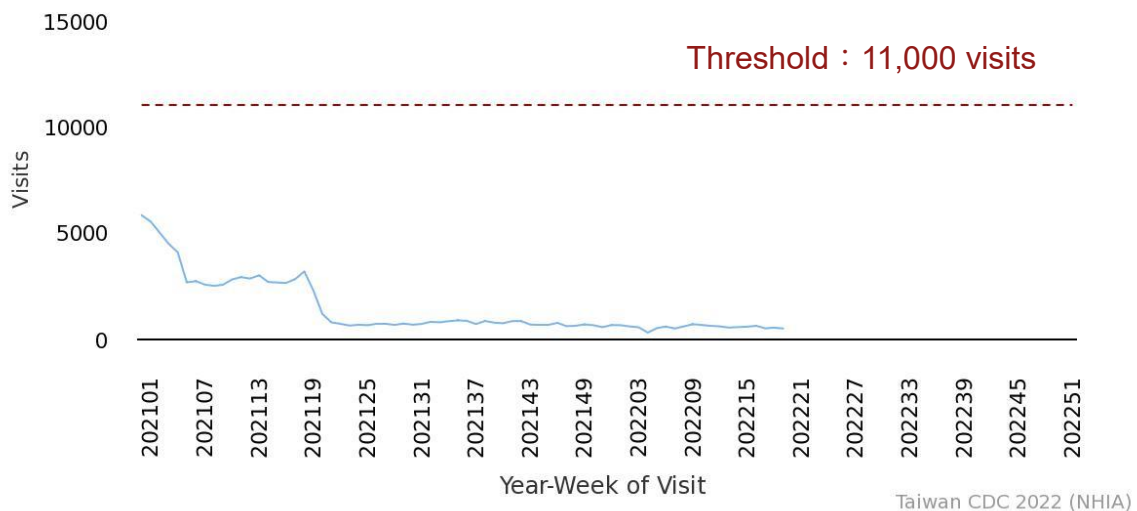
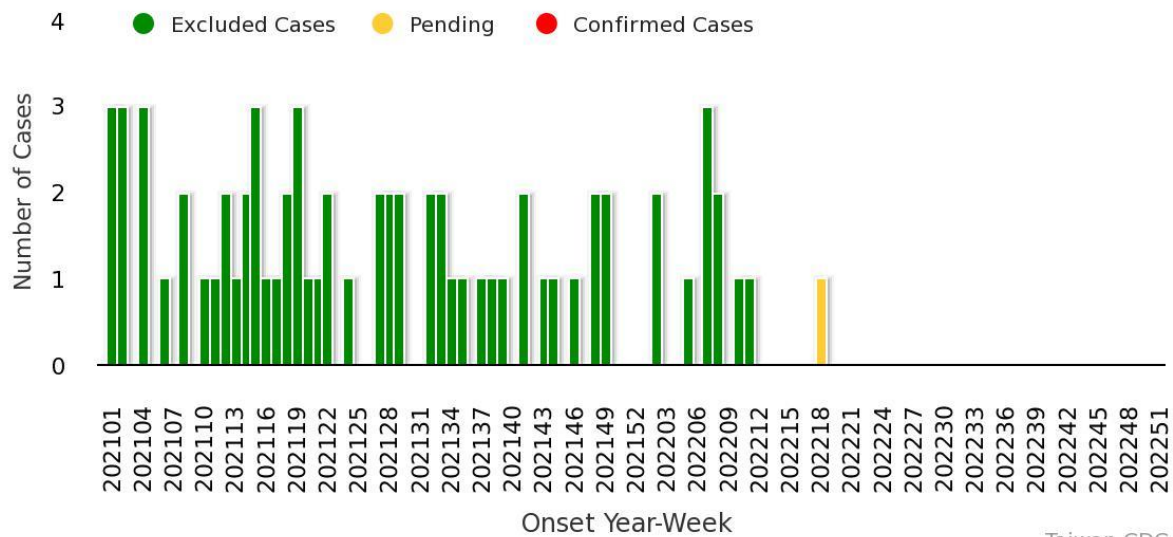


Figure 2. Trend of outpatient and ER visits for enterovirus infection, 2021-2022

According to the laboratory surveillance¹, the number of enterovirus isolates continued to be low in the past 4 weeks (Figure 1). During week 20, the total number of outpatient and ER visits for enterovirus infection was 471, which was far below the national baseline (11,000 visits), show as Figure 2.

As of May 23, 2022, no new EVSC² case was confirmed in 2022(Figure 3).
