


Summary


According to the laboratory surveillance¹, rhinovirus was dominant during recent weeks (Figure 1). During week 40, the total number of outpatient and ER visits for enterovirus infection was 583, which was far below the national baseline (11,000 visits), show as Figure 2.

As of October 10, 2022, no new EVSC² case was confirmed in 2022(Figure 3).


