Week 24, June 13 -19, 2021

Summary




Figure 1. Trend of Enterovirus Isolates, 2020-2021




Figure 2. Trend of outpatient and ER visits for enterovirus infection, 2020-2021

According to the laboratory surveillance¹, Coxsackie A was the predominant virus type in the past 4 weeks (Figure 1). During week 24, the total number of outpatient and ER visits for enterovirus infection was 603, which was far below the national baseline (11,000 visits), show as Figure 2.




Figure 3. Trend of EVSC, 2020-2021

As of June 21, 2021, no new EVSC² case was confirmed in 2021(Figure 3).
