



Summary

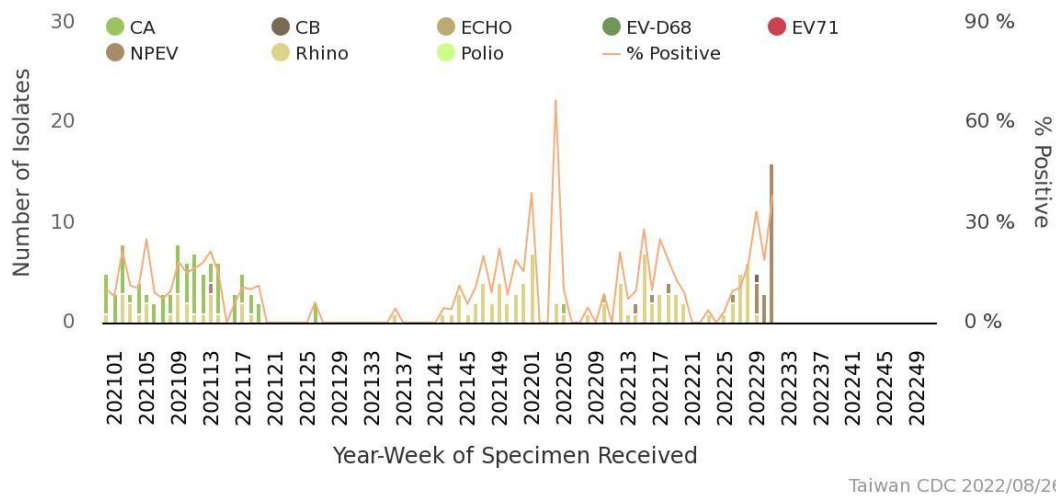


Figure 1. Trend of Enterovirus Isolates, 2021-2022

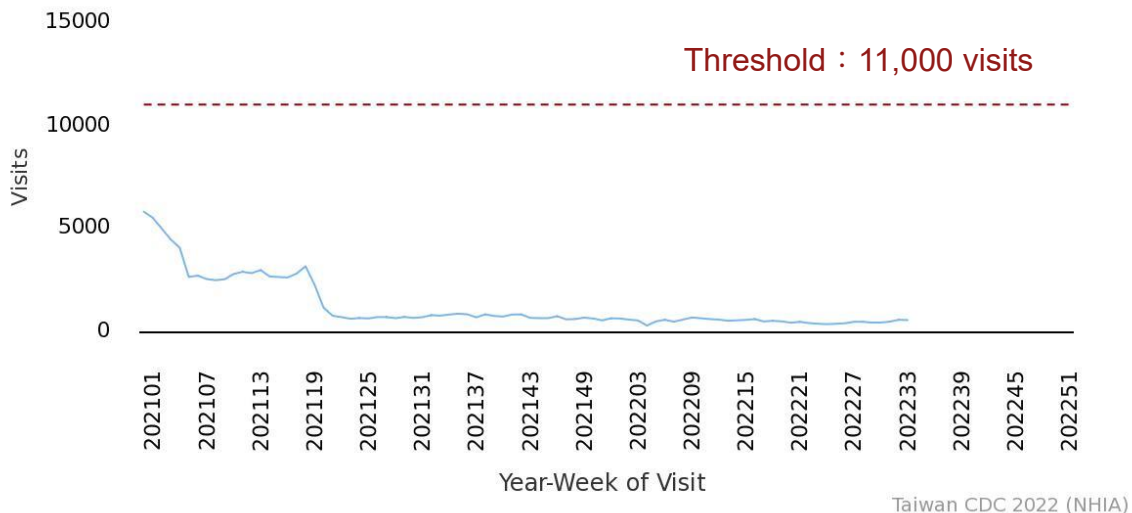
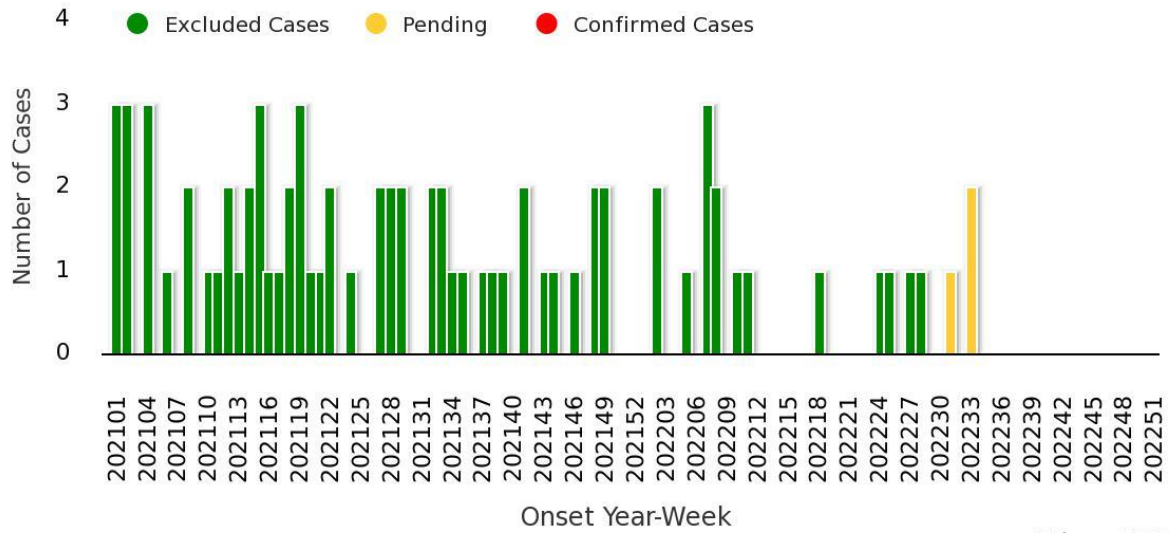


Figure 2. Trend of outpatient and ER visits for enterovirus infection, 2021-2022

According to the laboratory surveillance¹, rhinovirus was dominant during the past four weeks (Figure 1). During week 34, the total number of outpatient and ER visits for enterovirus infection was 549, which was far below the national baseline (11,000 visits), show as Figure 2.

As of August 29, 2022, no new EVSC² case was confirmed in 2022(Figure 3).
